North by Northeast Community Health Center is the only clinic in Oregon focused on African American health. We exist to improve health outcomes and advance health equity by offering primary care services focused on the local African American population. We serve as a primary care home for approximately 500 patients and offer a program of wellness and outreach activities including hypertension and diabetes classes, our Patient Wellness Council and our Cuts & Checks[™] barbershop blood pressure program.

In 2017 we held our first-ever fundraising event, which we called Community Supper. Over 400 donors, patients, community members, health system leaders, business partners and more celebrated our 10th anniversary by raising over \$80,000 to help carry our work into another year. In 2018, we replicated this success by raising even more money and celebrating with almost 500 friends.

We're thrilled to have the opportunity to hold our third Community Supper on May 19, 2018. Like the past two years' events, this year's Community Supper will include a program featuring client stories, entertainment, dinner and an auction. We hope that once again the event will bring together donors, patients, community members and leaders, businesses and foundations in a vibrant celebration. But we can't do it without some help! We're looking for individuals – and groups of individuals – to volunteer at the event to ensure it's a seamless, fun night for our guests. Volunteer roles include registration, raffle sales and greeting, and each role will require a 3-4 hour time commitment.
